The cook-off is a ALR 231 function and will be held at the American Legion Post 231 Camp Ground on October 6/7, 2017

All sites are Free Primitive camp sites. No Electricity Available
Portable Toilets On Site

CATEGORY ENTERED FOR TURN IN AND FOR 10 PEOPLE.
THIS IS TO RAISE THE FUNDS IN THE PEOPLES CHOICE CONTEST.**

Cook-off Rules

- (1). All entries will be cooked on site. Ribs, Brisket, Chicken, Beans & Peppers
- (2). Trophies will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place for all categories.
- (3). An Overall Trophy will be awarded to Overall Winner and A Dead Ass Last Trophy will be awarded to the last place contestant.
- (4). One Trophy will be awarded for People's Choice and one for Showmanship.
- (5). A MANDATORY COOK'S MEETING will be held Friday Night at 8:00 PM; this will also be the cut off time for entries.
- (6). Cookers may be started at 9 PM on Friday night, entries CANNOT be put on until 10 PM
- (7). Meats must be packed on ice. Meats cannot be marinated, rub applied or started prior to 10 PM Start Time. All meat is subject to the inspection of the BBQ Chairman. Any violations will be Disqualified. These conditions are in place to ensure freshness and sanitary conditions and to make it equal to all teams.
- (8). All Entries must be cooked on Wood Burning Pit, Charcoal or Gas BBQ Grill.
- (9). All entries will be judged on Appearance, Taste & Tenderness.
- (10). Turn In Boxes will be supplied by the Post for each entry, No Garnishes allowed in Turn in Box. Judging will be on the food not how good the box looks. All turn ins must be in the boxes provided.
- (11). A minimum of 5 pieces in each category of meats and peppers must be turned in

- (12). Teams must turn in each category at following times. Late Turn ins will be DISQUALIFIED.**
1:00 PM – RIBS 1:30 PM – CHICKEN 2:00 PM – BEANS
2:30 PM – BRISKET 3:00 PM – PEPPERS
- (13). People’s Choice and Showmanship will be held from 3:30 to 4:30 PM For a Donation of \$10 per Plate. Judging will be by the people and consist of a Ticket for People’s Choice and a Ticket for Showmanship provided with each plate. Each team will be provided two containers for these two categories and the people will vote after sampling each team’s food. All Tickets must be in place by 5:00 PM for Judges to pick up.**
- (14). Judging of Food will be blind, in that Judges will use a two part ticket, one part will be taped to bottom of your turn in container and one part will be loose inside your turn in container which you save and bring to Awards Ceremony at 6:PM. Lost Contestant Tickets will DISQUALIFY Possible winning entry**
- (15). No Commercial Barbecue Houses will be allowed.**
- (15). Each Team is Responsible for cleaning up and dumping all their trash grease and ashes. Trash bags and a Dumpster will be provided.**
