BARBECUE COOK-OFF

The cook-off is an ALR 231 function and will be held at the American Legion Post 231 Camp Ground on October 6-7 2023

There are 12 RV camp sites as well as primitive sites, Electricity and water is available at the RV sites. Available Portable Toilets on Site

NO ENTRY FEE IF TEAM COOKS ENOUGH OF EACH CATEGORY THEY ENTERED FOR TURN IN AND FOR 10 PEOPLE. THIS IS TO RAISE THE FUNDS IN THE BBQ COOKOFF.

Cook-off Rules

- (1). All entries will be cooked on site. Brisket, Pork Butt, Chicken, Beans & Peppers
- (2). Trophies will be awarded for 1st; 2nd place and Dead Ass Last for all categories.
- (3). A MANDATORY COOK'S MEETING will be held Friday Night Oct 6th @ 7:30 pm this will also be the cut off time for entries.
- (4). Cookers may be started at 8:00 pm on Friday night, **ENTREES CANNOT** be put on until After 9:00 pm
- (5). Meats must be packed on ice. Meats cannot be marinated, rub applied prior to 8:00 pm start time. All meat is subject to the inspection of the BBQ Chairman. Any violations will be Disqualified. These conditions are in place to ensure freshness and sanitary conditions and to make it equal to all teams.
- (6). All Entries must be cooked on Wood Burning Pit, Charcoal or Gas BBQ Grill.

No Pellet Cooker will be allowed.

- (7). All entries will be judged on Appearance, Taste & Tenderness.
- (8). Turn in Boxes will be supplied by the Post for each entry, No Garnishes allowed in Turn in Box. Judging will be on the food not how good the box looks. All turn ins must be in the boxes provided.
- (9). A minimum of 5 pieces in each category of meats and peppers must be turned in.
- (10). Teams must turn in each category at following times. Late Turn in's will be disqualified.

3:00 PM - CHICKEN

3:20 PM - BEANS

3:40 PM - BRISKET

4:00 PM- PORK BUTT

4:20 PM - PEPPERS

- (11). Judging of Food will be blind, in that Judges will use a two-part ticket, one part will be taped to bottom of your turn in container and one part will be loose inside your turn in container which you save and bring to Awards Ceremony at 6 pm. Lost Contestant Tickets will DISQUALIFY Possible winning entry
- (12). No Commercial Barbecue Houses will be allowed.
- (13). Each Team is Responsible for cleaning up and dumping all their trash grease and ashes. Trash bags and a Dumpster will be provided.
